combined with ultra-light backing, it is indistinguishable from solid marble, but offers greater resistance and lightness. Zunino Marmi uses this technology to create tops for bar counters, kitchens and bathrooms, flooring, complete wall systems and other custom made decorating accents.

Acoustic marble


supported by ad hoc technology to provide good quality acoustics where the presence of speakers or loudspeakers would diminish the value of classic marble wall and floor coverings.

Marble and leather

created for the design market: an intarsia technique which uses treated leather on a marble surface to create enjoyable, comfortable settings to be used indoors or out.

This technique can be applied to walls and floors, it is resistant to scuffing and comfortable for bare feet.

It offers wide possibilities for customisation, giving the designer the opportunity to create original and functional projects.

Zunino Marmi produces stairs, doorways, urban decorating elements, fountains, benches, fireplaces, columns, bathrooms and kitchens, flooring and wall coverings made from slabs taken from a single block of marble to maintain the grain of the stone.

A significant part of the company's production is destined to the realisation and installation of fittings for yachts, a sector in which the company has ten years of experience, with valuable fittings for large craft from the most prestigious shipyards to its credit.

Thanks to today's technology, stone can be combined with sophisticated materials to create high quality solutions.

Much time is dedicated to the search for ways to reduce weight, with proposals for installing lightweight marble vacuum bagged to an aluminium honeycomb backing, carbon fibre or ultra-light resin for excellent resistance and lightness.





Zunino Marmi's latest creation was presented at the 2010 Monaco Yacht Show:
a comfortable chaise longue
in Walnut travertine marble,
with sinuous curves made even softer
with weatherproof leather inserts

Its weight of a mere 30 kilos amazed the discerning visitors to the most important luxury boat show: a slab of travertine just a few millimetres thick positioned on an aluminium honeycomb backing supported by a carbon fibre structure. Two wheels inserted at the front facilitate moving the chaise longue.

The small table with refrigerated top, also in marble, makes it possible to keep foods and drinks cool and within reach by simply setting on the table top.
